The JESUS Film in O'odham language

In our last update, we shared a prayer request about my hope for there to be a Gospel (Luke) in video form that would be spoken in the Native American language. Well, praise God! We have secured a green light! The problem is that to keep the cost down, we will have to produce the raw audio for it ourselves. The challenge is in assembling believers who speak the native tongue and to record their native audio for integration with the existing video gospel. The timing of each spoken phrase will have to be a near perfect to match the actor's mouth movements.

Worldwide, "the Jesus Film" is a tremendous tool in effectively spreading the Gospel in more than a thousand languages. Hundreds of thousands of the unreached have come to redeeming faith in Christ when the movie is shown. It is so effective because it is "visual" with the words of Luke, Jesus, and

the other gospel characters in their own language, without even an accent.

Here are the needs:

1. O'odham believers to read and/or quote all the verses in Luke. **No problem.**
2. Basic good recording equipment. **Lord, you have it.**
3. Larger RV with space for use as a sound studio so we can move from village to village to be where the O'odham reader/speakers are. **Lord, show us the way...**
4. Funds for the production fees. Looks like just a few thousand dollars.

Please PRAY!

- That the enemy be restrained. He doesn't want the gospel spread.
- That the *right* reader/speakers to be cast.
- For the equipment and mobile facility.
- For a Production Fund. We have a hundred dollars in it now.

Everywhere you go people are talking about 2012. It seems that many centuries ago the ancient Mayans were able to extend their calendar only until the year 2012. It is not known if they had a reason for ending it that year or if they just "ran out of paper." Nevertheless, someone found the Mayan calendar with its final date of 2012 and now people all over the world who have a thirst for something sensationally "spiritual" are drinking from this well.

Christian brethren, this a time when the harvest is ripe! Ask God to make you one of the "laborers"...though they may be few. God has designed man with a hunger and thirst for the spiritual. It is our opportunity to show thirsting people how Christ will be revealed in the last day as the Lion of the Tribe of Judah. But don't leave it there. Please join us in prayer on a personal matter that affects ministry. When we purchased *The Sanctuary*...our 1994 travel trailer...our plan was to use it for retreats a week or two at a time, and for family camp-outs. We didn't know that the following year God would call us to be missionaries to the Native Americans in Arizona. We didn't know that our trailer would become our home for half of each year, and make many trips back and forth from Illinois to Arizona, as well as different locations on the mission field.

The Sanctuary has served us well but it has very limited closet and storage space. Most critical is the lack of space for office equipment. We have been able to create a temporary workspace for our computers and printers when the slide is out. But everything has to be disassembled every time we move. Also, since there is no storage space for office files and supplies, we must use plastic storage containers that take up most of our very limited living space.

Last year, we were privileged to have the use of a 5th wheel trailer for a few months. The extra 70 sq ft, with 2 slides, and a lot more storage made a tremendous difference, but the layout did not work well for us. That experi-

ence helped us to determine a floor plan that would work best for our needs.

A friend told us of a 2004, 36ft 5th wheel with 3 slides that is going to be put on the market because of health reasons. It meets the criteria on our needs list, has been used in ministry all of its life, and meticulously maintained. The most important thing is the dedicated office space... everything can be at fingertips all of the time, even while traveling. The layout would allow space for small group ministry as well as a sound studio.

Please join us in praying for restoration of the health of the owner and blessings upon this dear couple. Please pray for God's leadership and provision. Thank you.
